

Kitten and cat vaccination chart



8 – 10 weeks

- Three-in-one vaccine for feline parvovirus, herpesvirus, and calicivirus
- Feline leukaemia



10 – 14 weeks

Second doses three to four weeks after first.

- Three-in-one
- Feline leukaemia
- Rabies (from 12 weeks, given separately, and only needed if travelling abroad)



14 – 18 weeks

Third doses only given to high-risk cats.

- Three-in-one
- Feline leukaemia



Once a year

- Two-in-one vaccine for feline herpesvirus and calicivirus

Every three years

- Three-in-one
- Feline leukaemia
- Rabies (given separately, and only if travelling abroad)
